

## Beginner EAL Pronunciation Practice

Pronounce /d/ when words end in these voiced\* sounds:

/b/	I grabbed
/g/	she logged in
/l/	he called
/m/	it seemed
/r/	she cared
/v/	he lived
/z/	she sneezed
/ŋ/	we belonged

all vowels    she played

\*Voiced sounds have vibration in the vocal cords.

Pronounce /t/ when words end in these voiceless\* sounds:

/f/	he laughed (gh=f)
/k/	we baked
/p/	she helped
/s/	he missed

Pronounce an extra syllable /əd/ when the words end in these sounds:

/d/	he needed
/t/	she wanted

\*Voiceless sounds have very little vibration in the vocal cords.
